

# SPI Reading Presentation Rubric

	<b>EXCELLENT</b>	<b>GOOD</b>	<b>NEEDS IMPROVEMENT</b>
<b>PROJECTION OF VOICE</b>	Voice of the reader is heard loudly without the need for a microphone.	Voice of the reader is heard well but there are moments when voice is too low.	It is difficult to hear the reader.
<b>CLARITY</b>	Each word is pronounced clearly and never jumbled with other words. At no time can anyone be confused about what the reader is saying.	Most words are pronounced clearly with a few moments where the reader jumbles words together.	Reader often jumbles words together.
<b>PACE</b>	Presentation is never rushed. The reader makes strategic pauses allow the audience to follow along.	The presentation is sometimes rushed but there are some strategic pauses.	Most or all of the presentation is rushed.
<b>POSTURE</b>	For the duration of the reading, the reader stands tall without fidgeting (example: bouncing, shifting legs from side to side, twirling hair, etc.).	For most of the reading, the reader stands tall without fidgeting (example: bouncing, shifting legs from side to side, twirling hair, etc.).	The reader fidgets throughout the whole reading.
<b>EYE CONTACT</b>	The reader takes every available moment to look up from their reading material and give the audience eye contact.	The reader takes some moments to look up from their reading material and give the audience eye contact.	The reader never gives the audience eye contact.
